
IEMBA Program

1. Training Objective:

This program is for senior managers and business officials who are experienced in business administration. It aims to develop senior international managers with innovation ability, international vision and inter-cultural communication skills and keep them well informed with both transnational business models and Chinese commercial environment. Through this program, students can improve both their knowledge-integrating ability and decision-making and executive capacity.

2. Training mode:

- 1) Class Teaching: Considering the particularity of the composition of participants, IEMBA program adopts lectures, case studies, speeches, tutoring and other forms of flexible and diverse teaching methods;
- 2) Business Visits: To enhance participants' understanding of the Chinese business environment, IEMBA program provides regular arrangements for trainees to visit Development Zone, enterprises, rural suburbs of Beijing and government departments and invites local officials and business executives to hold seminars with the participants;
- 3) Cultural Experience: In addition to a monthly trip to rural suburbs of Beijing, IEMBA program also plans arrangements and study tours for participants to go out of the capital to experience Chinese culture.
- 4) Degree Granted: Program participants who acquire 21 compulsory credits, 9 elective credits and four business visits credits will be granted a MBA degree by UIBE.



Academic structure and Teaching Language

1. Academic structure: one year. Combined with practical teaching experiences of many years of English graduate programs for Foreign Students of our university, the program adopts "two big, one small" — a total of three semesters — training model and offers rolling admissions in spring and autumn. The detailed scheduler:

Fall semester: early September - the end of December (14 weeks)
Spring Semester: late February - the end of May (14 weeks)
Interterm: early June - mid July (a total of six weeks, including two weeks of business visits)

2. Teaching Language: English.

Admission requirements, Application period, Application materials and Registration Time

1. Admission Requirements:

- 1) Applicants participated in this program are required to be officials of division level and above with a bachelor's degree (or equivalent qualification) or Middle and senior management staff who engaged in the domestic operation or management and international economic cooperation.
- 2). Under the age of 45 with at least three years working experience.
- 3) Non-native English speaking Applicants must have English proficiency equivalent to IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL (IBT) 86 and above level
- 4) Applicants must be healthy and must not have any disease or situation listed below:
 - a) Diseases prohibited by Chinese Entry-Exit Inspection and Quarantine Laws and Regulations
 - b) Other severe chronic diseases like high blood pressure, cardio-cerebrovascular disease, diabetes; psychological diseases; or other infectious diseases which may harm public health
 - c) In recovery period after major surgery or acute disease attacks
 - d) Severe physically challenged
 - e) Pregnancy
- 5) Applicants are not allowed to bring spouse or any relative and friend during the study in China;
- 6) Only applicants recommended by the Embassy of the People's Republic of China will be considered and admitted.



2. Application Period

Fall Semester: April 1 - July 15

- A copy of TOEFL 86 above or IELTS 6.0 above or official letter of English proficiency, or passing the telephone test by UIBE faculty
